Students are not permitted to take any of the following into an examination hall:

- 1. Mobile Phone/ Smart Device**
- 2. Notes - written or typed**
- 3. Coats / Jackets**
- 4. Writing of any nature on one's equipment or one's person
e.g. on hands or arms**
- 5. Calculator cover**
- 6. Can or labelled bottle**
- 7. Any electronic device
(excluding non-programmable calculator)**
- 8. All articles which contain a digital screen or the ability
to communicate remotely**
- 9. Pencil case**
- 10. Glasses case**
- 11. Purse / Wallet**
- 12. Bag, including handbag**
- 13. All personal non-exam related items for example ornaments
artefacts and cuddly toys**
