

Procedure to be Implemented for Progression in the Case of Current Academics in the Area of Trades or Crafts

Procedure only for current staff employed by the Athlone Institute of Technology prior to 1 April 2010

1. At the time of application for progression have successfully completed a Postgraduate Certificate in Learning, Teaching and Assessment qualification or have obtained a minimum of 30 credits of the Postgraduate Diploma in Learning, Teaching and Assessment and have registered for a further 30 credits on this programme, which must be completed within 3 years of commencement of course, in order to maintain the progression, plus a minimum of 8 years relevant experience (in industry and/or teaching) obtained since meeting the minimum academic requirements
OR
2. Have at the time of application for progression obtained a primary honours degree – achieved since meeting minimum entry requirements plus a minimum of 8 years relevant experience (in industry and/or teaching) obtained since meeting the minimum academic requirements

The Institute will review other relevant qualifications on an individual basis.


The following procedure will be implemented for progression for academics in the Area of Trades or Crafts employed by Athlone Institute of Technology after 1 April 2010

1. In the case of trade or craft, have at the time of application for progression obtained a primary honours degree – achieved since meeting minimum entry requirements plus a minimum of 8 years relevant experience (in industry and/or teaching) obtained since meeting the minimum academic requirements.
OR
2. Have obtained the appropriate advanced qualification in relevant trade/craft – achieved since meeting minimum entry requirements (award must be examination and/or assessment based) plus a Postgraduate Diploma in Learning Teaching and Assessment qualification and a minimum of 8 years relevant experience (in industry and/or teaching) obtained since meeting the minimum academic requirements.


The Institute will review other relevant qualifications on an individual basis.

The Institute will support employees carrying out further studies.

All other procedures for Progression from Assistant Lecturer to Lecturer are as outlined in Circular Letter No. IT 03/05
