
Arising from recent queries, please find here clarification of the institute's requirements in respect of progression from Assistant Lecturer to Lecturer. The institute is guided in this matter by the Circular Letter 03/05 from the Department of Education and Science and by the clarification of same issued in November 2007. The latter is attached for your information.

The clarification attached outlines the requirements for progression. The institute requires a defined Masters in order to progress from Assistant Lecturer to Lecturer scale. While a Postgraduate Diploma is also placed at Level 9 on the National Framework of Qualifications, it is not deemed to be a defined Masters for the purpose of progression. Qualifications deemed to be equivalent to a Masters degree are outlined in the attached, under Qualifications A (2).
