<u>Tuition fees</u> may apply to some students (e.g. those repeating a year, or those who are not first time fulltime undergraduates). Where applicable, tuition fees must be paid in line with payment timelines detailed above. **Please contact the Fees Office directly.**

It is the responsibility of the student to inform the Institute of previous time spent in third level education. Failure to do so may result in the retrospective collection of fees.

EU STUDENTS

In order to qualify under the Free Fees Initiative (Tuition Fee Covered), applicants must:

- Be a first time undergraduate and
- Hold EU Nationality or official refugee status* and
- Have been ordinarily resident in an EU Member State for at least three of the five years preceding their entry to an approved third level course*.
 - * You may be required to provide proof of the above information to the Fees Office.

NON-EU STUDENTS

Students who reside in non-EU countries are liable for payment of fees at the non-EU rate:-

- Undergraduate Programmes €12,500 per annum
- Postgraduate Programmes €12,900 per annum

STUDENT GRANTS

Students must apply online to the grant awarding authority Student Universal Support Ireland (SUSI) at www.susi.ie

If you previously received a grant from SUSI you must ensure that you:

RENEW your application – where continuing your studies on the <u>same course</u>

APPLY – NEW – where entering a new or "add-on" course or changing course

APPLY - NEW -where continuing on a course but have never been in receipt of a student grant

Where official notification of a grant award is <u>not</u> received from SUSI, the Student Contribution Fee <u>must be paid</u> by the student. If a grant is subsequently awarded, the Student Contribution Fee will be refunded. Please note that the material fee is not covered by any grant payment.

Once registered the fee liability remains the sole responsibility of the student. If for any reason Third Party funding falls through the student remains liable for the fee due.
