

VETERINARY PLACEMENT AGREEMENT

This agreement deals with the compulsory professional work experience required to obtain a BSc in Veterinary Nursing in Technological University of the Shannon, Athlone Campus.

Clause 1 – This agreement is between:

THE FACULTY OF SCIENCE AND HEALTH, TECHNOLOGICAL UNIVERSITY OF THE SHANNON, ATHLONE CAMPUS

AND

THE VETERINARY CLINIC OR HOSPITAL (PLACEMENT PROVIDER)

AND

THE TECHNOLOGICAL UNIVERSITY STUDENT

Clause 2 – The duration of the placement is fixed. Please, check the dates provided. The hours of attendance are determined by the veterinary clinic/hospital (see guidelines in Placement Manual).

Clause 3 – During the length of the placement, the trainee remains a student and retains the same legal and insurance cover as when in TUS. Work or journey accident declarations are the responsibility of the student. Traveling to and from placement are not covered by the Institute's insurance.

Clause 4 – The trainee must respect the rules and regulations of the host organisation, particularly as far as the staff timetable and health and safety are concerned (see guidelines in Placement Manual).

Clause 5 – Trainee is not entitled to be paid by the host organisation.

Clause 6 – During the placement, the host supervisor shall certify that the student has completed the tasks/skills outlined in the student's handbook. At the end of the placement, TUS will request the completion of a placement feedback form by the placement supervisor.
